# Preventing vehicle crime

Police are urging members of the public to be more vigilant around creating opportunities for criminals who target vehicles.

Vehicle crime is one of the easiest types of crime to prevent, however due to the lack of vigilance, vehicle crime is prolific throughout the Auckland area.

## Preventing vehicle crime is very simple!

- Remove all valuable from your vehicle
- Use a steering wheel lock or brace, regardless if you have an alarm. (you can't see and alarm but a steering wheel lock is a great visual deterrence and cheap compared to other security options)

Offenders like easy opportunities, so if you remove temptation and make it more difficult to steal your car you are greatly reducing the chances of being victimized.
